#### Pastors Pen

In 1923 the words to the song "Great Is Thy Faithfulness" were put to music. Thomas Chisholm, the writer, suffered through the ups and downs of poor health throughout his life. The words from Lamentations 3:22-23, "His compassions fail not. They are new every morning; Great is Your faithfulness.", held special meaning for him as he discovered new blessings from God every morning even though he suffered. The song became a theme song for Dr. Will Houghton of the Moody Bible Institute but became popular through the singing of George Beverly Shea and the choirs accompanying the Billy Graham Crusades. With the beginning of Fall and the harvest season and the onset of some cooler weather, the words from the second verse of this great hymn have been in my heart and mind. "Summer and winter and springtime and harvest, Sun, moon, and stars in their courses above; Join with all nature in

manifold witness to Thy great

faithfulness, mercy and love."

As we and our neighbors continue to recover from Hurricane Idalia and as we watch the horror and devastation happening in Israel this past weekend more words from this great hymn bring comfort, "Pardon for sin and a peace that endureth, Thine own dear presence to cheer and to guide; Strength for today and bright hope for tomorrow, Blessings all mine, with ten thousand beside!"

I am so thankful for God's Great Faithfulness! When my faith is weak, Great is His Faithfulness! When I have doubts and fears, the Holy Spirit is with me to calm and to comfort. When I'm struggling to make sense of all that is happening around me, the truth in God's Word gives me clarity and understanding. When the world looks to be crumbling all around me, I can stand firm on the promises of God. "For all the promises of God have been fulfilled in Christ with a

resounding 'Yes!' And through Christ, our 'Amen' (which means 'Yes') ascends to God for His glory." 2 Corinthians 1:20 (NLT)

Over the next couple of weeks as you look at the cotton fields you will see a reminder of Jesus' words from Matthew 9:37-38, "The harvest truly is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send our laborers into His harvest." Right now there are many out there wondering about all that is going on in our world. They are looking for answers, help, and hope. Now is the time to tell them about God's Great Faithfulness and how your faith in Him gives you hope for tomorrow.
